SUMMARY:

Photographers are members of the Retail team that specialize in the capture and sales of souvenir photographs to Aquarium visitors. This position can be fast-paced and high volume but requires a helpful, friendly approach at all times.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- As a member of the Retail team, you will lead by example by being patient, kind, humble, respectful, selfless, forgiving, honest and committed when interacting with one another and guests.
- Understand the importance of the position with how it relates creating a memorable shopping experience. Pro-active, friendly communication will be expected at all times.
- Proactively greet guests and offer them the opportunity to allow their photo to be taken. Provide them with all information they need to view and purchase their photo(s) at the viewing/point-of-sale location
- Learn and become proficient with the technology and techniques needed to shoot professional-grade photos.
- Perform all functions at the photography point of sale including photo recall, edits/enhancements, printing, packaging and sale transaction.
- Accurately and efficiently conduct all sales transactions. Account for all monies, coupons, passes and vouchers received at the end-of-shift settlement. Proactively up-sell guests where appropriate.
- Work as a member of a team; within the Retail department and the rest of the Aquarium staff. Effectively communicate to the rest of the team information that is relevant to the shopping experience.
- Coach each other to continually improve performance and embrace feedback from crew and management. Through an open door policy, address performance issues pertinent to the store and team, make recommendations for areas of improvement throughout the store. Contribute to a work environment that is satisfying, enjoyable and energetic.
- Comply with safety and security directives, policies and procedures.
- Performs other related duties as assigned.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- High school diploma or equivalent and 1-2 previous retail, customer service or attraction experience preferred.
- Friendly, outgoing and proactive personality.
- Ability to learn and perform all Retail job functions.
- Ability to work as a member of a team.
- Ability to work a variety of shifts including weekends, evenings and holidays.
- Ability to handle and account for large sums of money.
- Good communication and computer skills.

PHYSICAL AND MEDICAL REQUIREMENTS:

- Successful completion of a pre-employment drug testing and background investigation.
- No allergy to plants or animals which may interfere with ability to work.
- Ability to stand for long periods of time.
- Ability to lift and carry up to 50 pounds to stock merchandise.
- Able to have mobility great enough to kneel, bend, reach, twist and move about to handle transactions and stocking.
- Dexterity is required for the operation of register/computer and related equipment.
